*I plan to build the stadiums using my own construction methodology*

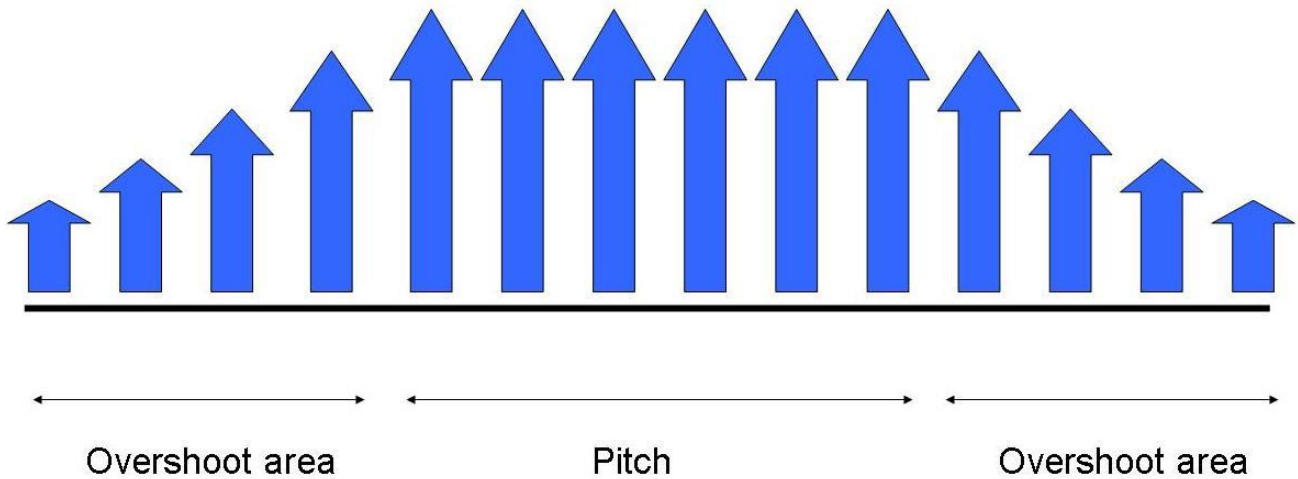


*I'll outline some basic ideas*

I would use a series of small electric fans, say about four in series, for each point in my fan array on my pitch, rather than using larger fans. Going electric is *more silent*, and I would have the air tunnels so soundproofed anyway that the only sound heard would be the airflow, not the motors.

In addition having a large number of smaller fans allows a more *even flow of air* in my stadium, cutting down on turbulence and air-pockets.

*For safety, have the vertical column of air extending for a distance beyond the pitch boundary, but with the airflow getting less as you leave the pitch area*

This leads then to an area of big foam cushions. The idea is that if a person overshoots the pitch they do not suddenly drop out of the sky, but rather gradually lose altitude and then come to land safely on the foam cushions.

That's the basic idea. I have a bit more but that's enough to give people the idea.
